SCHOOL FEES UPDATE

Over the years, the school has always given a long duration of grace for parents to pay up their children's fee before the term comes to an end. This method hasn't helped us as the school has continued to suffer huge financial losses yearly.

Some of the affected parents end up accumulating high bills and leave for a lower school or travel abroad, thereby leaving these bills unpaid. We can no longer continue with this

method because of some ugly experiences. Going forward, management has decided that fees be paid upon resumption of a new term

. The discount period shall only apply if fees are paid before resumption. A grace period of (2) weeks will be given upon resumption, after which school fees drive will commence.


